

# Roseberry Invitational Bunkai Registration

## (Rules and Scoring)

NOTE: To enter the bunkai part of the contest, both participants must be registered (kata) participants in the Roseberry Invitational. You may not enter the bunkai aspect solely.

Traditional SRSBK Kata Bunkai

Junior and Senior divisions in Child, Youth and Adult and a master's division for Adult Nidan and above.

Some examples; a youth white and green could partner, or an adult brown and Shodan,

If a child pairs with a youth they will be in the youth division.

Format & scoring are the same as for kata, with only one bunkai used.

The 1st time they will perform the junior attacks ½ of the bunkai.

The 2nd time they will perform the senior attacks ½ of the bunkai.

Scores for each half are added together for the final score.

This should be a formal presentation, Slow down and be deliberate in your actions.
